Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 11 Results Day

We hope that year 11 students are enjoying the summer holidays and having a much-deserved rest in preparation for the next stage of their education in September. During their time away from school we hope that they have been able to access some of the bridging work provided on the school website to support with a smooth transition into post 16 education.

As you know GCSE results day will be on Thursday 12th August. We are inviting Year 11 students to collect these in the school hall between 9:00am – 11.00am.

Unfortunately, it will not be possible to bring friends and family members to collect results this year as we wish to limit numbers on the school site. Students should arrive at the entrance to the school hall no earlier than 8:55am.

Students will pick up their own results envelope, clearly marked with their name from the main hall, following a one-way system. They will sign a form to confirm collection of their GCSE results. We request that students bring their own pen. If you are unable to attend Results Day, you may authorise a third party to collect results on your behalf. If this is your preferred method, a letter of authorisation will need to be given to your nominated person to bring on the day. Suitable identification will need to be provided by the third party, for example, a driving licence, photo card or passport.

Please also find attached detailed information about the appeals process, this can also be found on the school website.

The details in this letter and attachment should be read carefully and kept in a safe place for future reference. We look forward to seeing year 11 students in school on results day.
