

Destinations: Cohort 2018- 19



Headlines:

This cohort comprised 43 (56%) students of which 24 students accepted Degree courses at University. Of these, 11 (46%) students secured places at Russell Group Universities: Birmingham, Sheffield, Nottingham, Warwick, Bristol and Liverpool.

Students applying for higher level apprenticeships increased this year with seven (16%) students starting apprenticeships in the local vicinity in a variety of disciplines including: Marketing, Accountancy, Insurance, Finance and Retail.

Six (15%) students have entered the world of work – and have workplace traineeships in the local area.

Five (14%) students are taking a gap year. Of these, four are re-applying to University and at the time of writing, the other two are re-considering what to study.

Distance from Hazel Grove:

Students tend to cluster in the North West and North East for University, Apprenticeships and Workplace Traineeships. In fact, 56% of students stayed in the Stockport-Manchester area and 82% within a 50-mile radius. The furthest north was Leeds, the furthest east was Nottingham, the furthest west was Bristol and the furthest south was Bristol/Warwick.

Future Options:

56% of students chose to study degree level courses as opposed to 31% of students who chose to follow the Apprenticeship or Traineeship routes. There were 14% of students who have decided to delay entry to University for a variety of reasons for example, one student needed a valid driving licence in order to pursue a course in Paramedic Science and another decided to re-apply for Veterinary courses after unsuccessful entry this year. This year, students opting for BA degrees (58%) outweighed those starting BSc (29%) courses. However, we successfully supported three (4%) students to join competitive courses in Medicine and Veterinary science.
