**Multi Factor Authentication:** Year 12 students, please make sure you have set up MAF (Multi Factor Authentication), this must be done by 23<sup>rd</sup> June. You have been emailed instructions, however, if you need any assistance please come to the office.

(Most universities now have Open Days at the weekend).
